



## What are the benefits of the HPi6s over the HP203?

- **LCD Screen:** 320 x 240 dots graphic color LCD (vs. 3 digit LED Screen); allows you to see song names, tone names, and makes the piano much easier and more intuitive to operate
- **DigiScore:** Read music in the LCD screen which is in the proper location...*same location that you would place a music book.*
- **Visual Lesson:** Get graded or scored on your performance, motivates students to improve their score/performance.
- **Practicing:** Move to any measure in a piece easily with dedicated measure buttons. Move to beginning of a song easily with dedicated reset button. A/B Marker and Repeat function for practicing problem spots.
- **Track Muting:** *Button Mode:* 5 buttons on panel to simply turn off Rhythm or Accompaniment; *Screen Mode:* Solo or Mute any of the 16 tracks.
- **Wonderland:** Games to help piano students learn rhythm, notes, and fingering, as well as activities to help non-piano students become interested in music making.
- **File Management:** Easily find your songs and folders on memory stick, everything is in alphabetical order, no folder or song limit (vs. 20 folder limit, 99 song limit per folder, somewhat random order)
- **Recording:** 16 Track (vs. 3 track); Song Editing: Go to any measure to restart recording, quantize (correct timing mistakes), note edit (correct note mistakes), cut, copy, paste, erase, delete, part exchange, transpose, PC edit (change the sound)
- **155 Additional Sounds:** 461 Sounds (vs. 306)
- **Speakers:** 12 cm x 2 bass, 5cm x 2 tweeter (vs. 12 cm x 2)
