Powering Up

1. Press POWER button (on right)

Listening to a Song

- 1. Turn VOLUME knob to desired volume
- 2. Insert memory stick and press
- 3. Select desired Song Folder using + or − and then press to open the folder
- and then press to open the folder

 4. Select desired Song using + or − and then press then press to open the folder
- To hear that song again, press ⊕, then
- 6. To listen to all songs in a folder without stopping, press while holding .
 7. To exit a Song Folder press until (Up)
- To exit a Song Folder press until (Up) appears and then press •

Changing Tempo (speed)

- 1. Press ==
- 2. Press the + or button
- 3. To hear the tempo, press



4. To stop the metronome, press again
5. To return to the original tempo, press – and + at the same time

Turning Tracks On and Off (controlling what you hear)

- 1. Touch a track button to turn it either on (lit) or off (not lit)
- 2. Track R is rhythm, Track 2 is accompaniment, Track 3 is left hand and Track 4 is right hand
- Track 1 is usually off because it is generally used for student recording

Going to a Particular Measure

- Press or to get to the desired measure
- For songs that have 1 or 2 "count-in" measures, add that number to each measure of the printed music to find the measure number on the disk

Setting Practice Loops

Your goal is to play the song all the way through without pauses. A practice loop will help you learn your song section by section.

1. Press

- 2. Use or to select the measure for the marker
- 3. Pressing sets Marker A
- 4. Select the next measure and then press + to place Marker B
- 5. Turn on □ and •••••
- 6. Press to begin
- 7. Gradually increase your tempo as you become more comfortable
- 8. To clear the markers you set, while holding press to delete MARKER A and press + to delete MARKER B

Setting a Count-In

Most songs have one or two measures of "count-in" at the beginning to establish the beat

- If you want a 2-measure count-in when starting somewhere other than the beginning of the song, press , then press
- 2. To turn off •••••, press again

Transposing

- 1. While holding D, press **R**
- 2. Use or + to adjust by half steps

Tuning to an off-pitch acoustic piano

- 1. While holding , press 1
- 2. Press 🕒
- 3. While you are hearing the "A" frequency being generated from the MT90S, repeatedly play A above middle C on your piano and use or + to adjust the frequency to your piano. (440.0 is the normal pitch)

Other

1. While holding , try pressing any other button. Lots of hidden functions. Have fun!
